Statement of Need

The PCC wishes to improve the Lady Chapel, provide facilities for congregation/visitors who have had hip replacements or suffer mobility issues, improve the flexibility of the west end of the north aisle and increase storage space.

- 1. At the moment the Lady Chapel, Area A on the floor plan, only has seating which faces sideways to the altar. Pew 1 is unsafe to use and faces away from the main altar so could not be used for main services even if repaired.
- 2. Replace the removed pew with half depth, standard height cupboards which would modestly increase storage which we need to house worship and children's resources.
- 3. Place two chairs with higher seats and arms facing in towards the Lady Chapel altar. This would give a more private, intimate feel to the Lady Chapel and the chairs could be turned to face the main altar for use in services.
- 4. Pew 3 is unsafe. We would replace this pew with Pew 2. Removal of Pew 2 would increase the space around the entrance and access to the main noticeboard..
- 5. Remove Pews 4-6 and replace them with chairs to match those already in front of pews 4-6. This would improve the flexibility of this large area; at the moment we have to manhandle the pews to create space for such events as the Christmas Tree Festival.
- 6. The south aisle already has a mixture of pews towards the rear and 3-4 rows chairs at the front
